Sports Stadium Louvres

Naco 75 performance and 50 series louvres

Naco 75 performance and 50 series louvres have recently been supplied and fixed to a new sports stadium.

The stadium was worth £32 million in total and louvres have been fitted at each 'corner' of the stadium and are finished in polyester powder coating, coordinated with the building cladding system. The main areas of louvre provide active ventilation to the plant rooms while there are additional runs of smaller louvres providing both active and decorative functions.
